Specialist teacher in Infant sports teaches above the minimum requirement in PE in the curriculum. School staff observe specialist teacher on a weekly basis to build confidence and subject knowledge in PE.	Improve the quality of the sports provision throughout the School by increasing the confidence, knowledge and skills of teaching staff in teaching PE and Sport.	£4000
Provision of regular forest school sessions for all children throughout the year for sustained periods of time.	Children have the opportunity to learn active outdoors skills, to work independently and collaboratively, developing social skills in negotiation, turn taking, listening and contributing to ideas. Children are active outside throughout the seasons and learn to understand how the environment changes and what they must do to look after it. They become skilled at using a variety of tools for activities such as whittling and firelighting.	£4000
Weekly swimming lessons at Cranleigh Leisure Centre.	Build on the number of opportunities for varied types of exercise during the School week. Children have weekly swimming lessons at a local pool with specialist teachers and learn how to keep safe in and around water.	£3000
Re marking the playground following the re surfacing last year.	Children use the playground facilities and markings to maximise and vary their physical activities.	£3000
Purchase new ride on bikes and pedal bikes, minor repairs on climbing frames and rope balances.	Improve the range of activities at playtimes to ensure all children are enjoying 30 minutes activity per day.	£1750
New forest school equipment eg hammocks, whittling tools, fire lighters, ropes, tarpaulins etc.	Children engage in more varied forest school activities by interacting with equipment and learning new skills.	£400

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
